They voted on the games, and then they used their funds from the movie night popcorn sales to purchase them for the school. We're planning one more before the year ends, and the leaders want to focus on snacks.
- Our Spring Concert was last night. Grades 3-5 performed with hand bells, recorders and various songs. We had a healthy turnout, as always. We had a special dance number coordinated by Mrs. Stanfield and taught in her PE classes.

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

- The Spring Fling was a great success. Games were played, prizes were earned, cakes were won, baskets were auctioned, and raffles were drawn. There was a great turnout, with more than \$12,000 earned this year. They are excited to be moving forward with equipment purchases soon.
- Grandparents Day is April 11th. We expect more than 100 visitors to our classrooms that afternoon. Each classroom is planning ways for families to connect and for kids without visitors to also take part. As we did last year, Book Fair will be over before grandparents arrive.
